## 2014 Summer Recreation (Full-Day) Camps

*For children Ages 7-12 • Limited number of Financial Aid & POC scholarships available for WEEKS 1-8

**REGISTRATION:** Pre-registration is required. A \$25, non-refundable deposit is required to reserve a spot for each session; all balances are due two weeks prior to the start of camp. Applications are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.

**LUNCH / SNACKS:** Campers must bring their own lunch and morning and afternoon snacks each day. Food Bank is available at select sites.

**CAMP FORMAT:** Camps run from 9am–4pm, Monday through Friday. Pre-care is available at all sites from 7:30am. After-care is available to 5:30pm at all camp locations.

**ACTIVITIES:** Daily camp programming includes arts/crafts, weekly themes, fitness and nature activities, sports games and contests, and recreational & educational programming.

**FIELD TRIPS:** Camp includes a swimming trip and one field trip per week (no additional cost, except a non-refundable activity fee of \$15 per week, per child must be provided for POC registrants). Children will be transported to sites that offer roller skating, swimming, and bowling, a water park, Carousel Park, Franklin Institute, a Blue Rocks Game and more.

### TEN WEEKLY SESSIONS - Camps are \$120 per week (\$105 for Jun 30 –July 4)

Extended care options at all sites available. Pre-care & After-care is \$35 per week for both 7:30am-9 & 4-5:30 p.m.
