FISCAL NOTE: This Resolution authorizes the execution of one purchase order contract totaling \$37,000.00. Funding is included in the FY2019 Approved Operating Budget.

R18-104: AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO EXECUTE A FINANCING AGREEMENT WITH THE DELAWARE WATER POLLUTION CONTROL REVOLVING FUND, ACTING BY AND THROUGH THE DELAWARE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$835,000, TO FUND THE RETROFIT OF THE MORNINGSIDE, HUNTERS RIDGE AND PERCH CREEK STORMWATER BASINS; PROVIDING FOR THE PURCHASE OF THE BOND; AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF VARIOUS DOCUMENTS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH. FISCAL NOTE: This Resolution pledges the full faith, credit and taxing power of the County to the prompt payment of the principal of, premium, if any, and the interest on the Bond.

<u>°18-071:</u> TO AMEND *NEW CASTLE COUNTY CODE* CHAPTER 14 ("FINANCE AND TAXATION") TO IMPLEMENT A NEW CASTLE COUNTY ACCOMMODATION TAX FOR HOTEL, MOTEL, AND TOURIST HOME STAYS. Introduced by: Mr. Smiley, Mr. Cartier, Mr. Sheldon

FISCAL NOTE: This Ordinance is expected to increase General Fund revenues by the following amounts:

FY 2019: \$2.4 million (partial year)

FY 2020: \$3.1 million FY 2021: \$3.2 million

<u>°18-072:</u> AMEND THE GRANTS BUDGET: APPROPRIATE FUNDING FROM NEW CASTLE COUNTY COUNCIL TO THE SENIOR HOME REPAIR PROGRAM GRANT, WHICH IS ADMINISTERED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY SERVICES. Introduced by: Mr. Tackett

FISCAL NOTE: This Ordinance, if approved, will amend the Grants Budget by appropriating \$4,600 in funding to the Senior Home Repair Program Grant, which is administered by the Department of Community Services. Partial funding for this program will be provided from the County Council – Grants and Fixed Charges Budget Line Item in the FY2018 Approved Operating Budget.

The Senior Home Repair Program Grant is designed to provide minor housing repair assistance to eligible senior homeowners age 60 and older, who own and reside in their home as their primary residence, have assets under the asset limit and have homeowners insurance. The maximum grant amount is \$2,500. The home must be located in New Castle County, outside the boundaries of Wilmington and Newark. There are currently over 170 seniors on the waiting list for this program. Funding for the program is from the Community Development Block Grant Program.

The fiscal impact of this Ordinance, if approved, will be an increase in the authorized spending authority of the Grants Budget by \$4,600. This increase will affect FY2018 and beyond since this program is ongoing, without an expiration date, until all funds have been expended.

<u>°18-073:</u> AMEND THE FY2018 APPROVED OPERATING BUDGET: REDUCE THE GRANTS AND FIXED CHARGES BUDGET LINE ITEM OF COUNTY COUNCIL TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE SENIOR HOME REPAIR PROGRAM GRANT. Introduced by: Mr. Tackett

FISCAL NOTE: This Ordinance, if approved, will amend the FY2018 Approved Operating Budget by reducing the County Council – Grants and Fixed Charges Budget Line Item by \$4,600 and transferring those funds to the Senior Home Repair Program Grant.

There will be no net fiscal impact if this Ordinance and its companion Ordinance are approved. The resulting effect will be the transfer of \$4,600 of FY2018 Approved Operating Budget spending authority to the Grants Budget. There is no fiscal impact beyond FY2018.
