- **ORDINANCE NO. 20-002** **Introduced by: Mr. Bell, Mr. Street**
AMEND THE GRANTS BUDGET: APPROPRIATE \$39,069.48 IN EMERGENCY ILLEGAL DRUG ENFORCEMENT (EIDE) FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF DELAWARE, DEPARTMENT OF SAFETY AND HOME LAND SECURITY TO THE EIDE-FY2020 DRUG CONTROL OVERTIME GRANT, TO BE ADMINISTERED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY
 - Colonel Vaughn Bond gave an overview of the EIDE Grant stating the grant money will be used to help with drug investigations and undercover drug investigations.
