1. Call to Order: Meeting was called to order at 3:00 p.m.
2. Approval of Minutes from the January 23, 2018 meeting: A motion was made by Councilman Smiley and seconded by Councilwoman Kilpatrick to adopt the minutes. The minutes were accepted by Council.

Giles spoke on behalf of the town of Elsmere and what the library has meant over the years.
