3. ORDINANCE NO. 19-068

AMEND THE GRANTS BUDGET: REALIGN \$147,425.92 IN STATE FUNDING WITHIN THE FY2019 FUND TO COMBAT VIOLENT CRIMES GRANT, WHICH IS ADMINISTERED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY.
