



Information regarding The Health Insurance Marketplace (For Seasonal and Part-Time Employees of New Castle County)

The Marketplace is the way millions of uninsured Americans are getting affordable, high quality health insurance coverage. The Health Insurance Marketplace helps people who need health insurance coverage to find it. When you fill out the Marketplace application, you will find out if you qualify for a private health insurance plan and whether you qualify for lower costs based on your household size and income. Some people may qualify for Medicaid and Children's Health Insurance Programs in their state. Even if you don't qualify for lower costs, you can still use the Marketplace to buy insurance.
