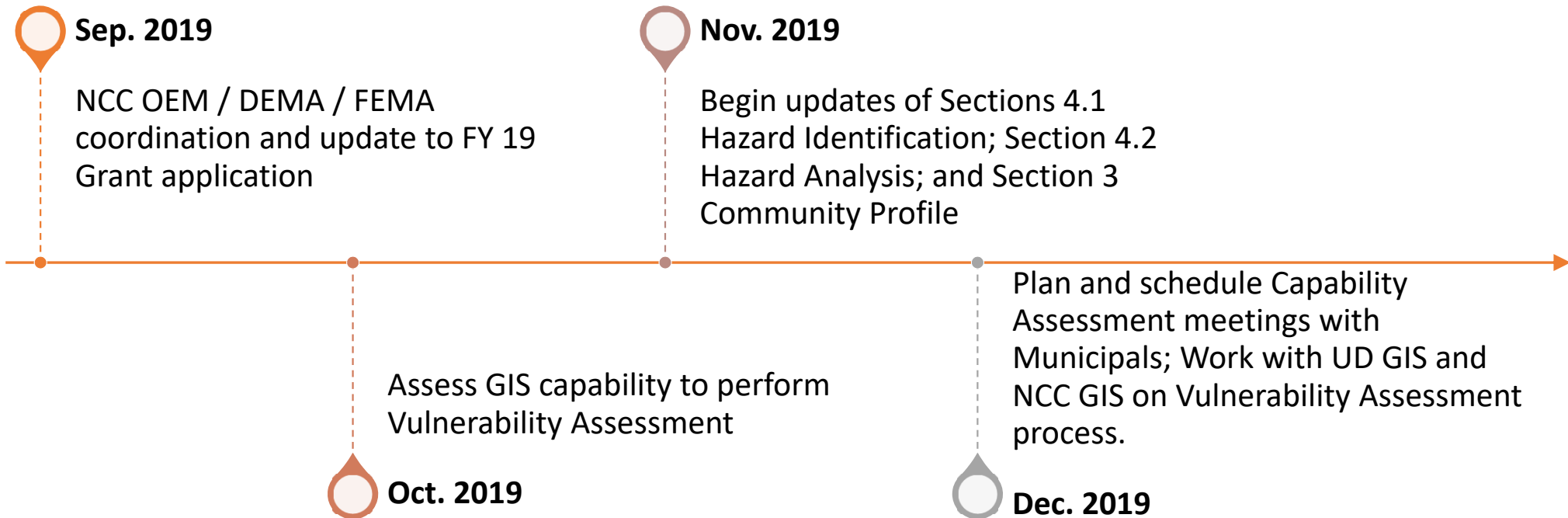
What does this Plan cover ?

- A FEMA Requirement based upon the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, requiring this Plan to identify hazards, vulnerabilities, strategy, and actions in order to apply for any Federal Disaster Assistance or Federal Mitigation Grants.
- Focus in 2010 on strictly Natural Hazards, with continuing comments on other hazards.
- NCC's Plan is Multi Jurisdictional, and is adopted by all 13 Municipals and the University of Delaware.

What is the Purpose of today ?

- Criteria set by FEMA for specific planning tasks and documentation of those tasks, along with input by various stakeholders and the public.
- Current 2015 Plans expires May 27, 2020 – Update needs to be submitted 45 days prior
- Present to County Council the current status of our update and welcome any input
- Current Time Line of Plan Update – all being conducted by NCC Staff

Plan and schedule Capability Assessment meetings with Municipals; Work with UD GIS and NCC GIS on Vulnerability Assessment process.

Jan. 2020

Meet with Municipals for Capability Assessment and Actions Review; GIS Begin Vulnerability Assessment

2 Mar.

Stakeholder Meeting for Vulnerability Assessment Review and New Mitigation Action prioritization.

1 Apr.

Send Final Draft Plan to DEMA/FEMA for Review and Approval

Continue Municipal Meetings; Schedule two required Public Meetings, 1st is 2/25 Council Exec. Committee

3 Mar.

What items have been updated for NCC ?

- Flood Maps, and our Community Rating System status increase
- Comprehensive Land Use Plans

What is the Mitigation Strategy ?

- Mission Statement – develop a comprehensive program guided by technology and data, improved communications, and sound planning, to reduce vulnerability.
- Goals – Specifically detailed based upon the Mission Statement.
- Actions based upon Prevention, Open Space Protection, Outreach and Coordination, Emergency Services, and Property Protection.
